This section includes the timeliness in payment of fees as well as refunds for the MLS Program

Principle

This section defines when MLS Program fees need to be paid and the protocol for refunds if a student voluntarily withdraws from the Program.

Procedure	Steps	Actions
Option #1	1.	The school requires the payment of a \$3500 fee for the clinical year. This fee is the same for resident and nonresident students. The students will be responsible for the additional purchase of textbooks, usually costing approximately \$750 (non-refundable). The school offers two payment policies to the students as follows: The fee of \$3500 may be paid in a single payment within the first week of school. The following refund schedule will be used if the student voluntarily withdraws for academic reasons.
		Withdrawal during the first 3 months 75% Withdrawal during months 4 through 6 50% Withdrawal during months 7 through 9 25% Withdrawal after month 9 0% If a student is dismissed by the MLS Program Director, as outlined in the MLS Student Handbook, there will be no refund.
Option #2	2.	The \$3500 fee may be paid in the following increments. The first payment is due within the first week of school and subsequent payments due every three months. The fees will be due within the week of the following dates: Second week of June \$875 Last week of August \$875 Second week of Nov. \$875 Last week of Jan. \$875 These payments are non-refundable and must be completed within the stated dates for continuation in the program. If payments are not timely, the student must make special arrangements with the hospital and program director or be suspended from classes.
Text Books Purchase	3.	Book purchases are to be completed within the first week. These costs vary from year to year and will be made known to the students as soon as possible before the starting date.
