Transportation Services

Transportation provided to medically related appointments anywhere in the greater Kansas City area. Individuals may use this service up to 4 round trips per month.

Cost to seniors per one-way trip:
\$5.00 for ambulatory rides.
\$10.00 for special wheel-chair transportation.

Call our scheduling & dispatch service, Assisted Transportation, at **913.262.8600** no later than noon the business day before the appointment.

In-Home Services

Limited in-home support, may include light housekeeping, personal care assistance, respite for the primary caregiver, and care management.

Co-pays for in-home services are based on the seniors' income.

Devices for seniors to summon help in the event of a fall or other urgent medical matter. Clay County Senior Services will pay a portion of the monthly service fee.
